- Marlowe, Christopher (Kit): myth about xi, xii, xiii; childhood in Canterbury, attends King's School 1-8; attends Corpus Christi, Cambridge 9-21, 25-7; visits Rheims 22-5; goes to London, meets Thomas Watson 28-32; *Tamburlaine* staged 33-5, 38-46; joins in discussions of School of Night, begins *Doctor Faustus* 55-7, 64-6; *Tamburlaine* and Spenser's *The Fairie Queene* share some lines 58-62; irony in *The Jew of Malta* 70-2; sword fight between Marlowe and Watson, and Bradley 73-5; inquest 76; Newgate Prison 77-9; influence of Bradley affray on Marlowe's writing 80-4; contrast of this with *Hero and Leander* and *Doctor Faustus* 83-5; involvement with other playwrights including Thomas Kyd 90-3, 96-102; *Edward II* and court favourites 103-110; visits Holland and meets Baines 103-4; disturbs the peace in Holywell Street 111; visits Canterbury 113-14, 116; visits Scadbury because of plague, finishes *Doctor Faustus* 117, 120-7; *Hero and Leander* inspires Shakespeare's *Venus and Adonis* 128-132; 'other poet' of Shakespeare's Sonnets 132-5; accused by Kyd of atheism 137-140; Frizer kills 'Morley' 140-3; 'Marlowe' in burial entry 144; posthumous praise and occasional vilification 149-57; 'beauty' creed in *Tamburlaine* 158
